Lafayette Winona Civic League Minutes

The 6:30 – 7:00 pm Social was followed by the 7 pm Pledge and meeting, conducted by President John Saetta.

Guest Speaker: Agnes M. Flemming, Environmental Health Manager, Norfolk Dept. of Public Health, shared information on mosquito and vermin control, including:

Mosquitoes: Eliminate damp areas and water catching containers; scour bird-baths; homeowners may use a “BTI” produce to kill larvae.

Only 12 inspectors monitor the entire city.

If mosquitoes are identified as disease carrying, the City may use fogging.

Rats: Kill rats before cleaning up litter where they are nesting.

Eliminate birdseed/dogfood to discourage rodents.

Important: in Norfolk, homeowners are responsible for baiting and killing rats.

Crime Report: Community Resource Officer R. Paschal’s report included 10 larcenies, and a reminder to remove valuables from cars, and to lock cars, sheds and houses!
